GENERAL INFORMATION REGARDING A SPECIALTY PLATE

- This application, with Sections A and D completed in full, must be returned to the organization official for submission to the Department. No applications sent directly to the Department by the organization member will be processed. All applications must be sent to the Department by the organization.
- The applicant listed in Section A must be a registered owner of the vehicle as indicated on the vehicle's registration credential. If the vehicle is a leased vehicle, Form MV-1L, "Application for Lessee Information", must be completed and attached. (Note: Form MV-1L is available on our website at www.dmv.state.pa.us.)
- Fee required with this application is \$20.00. The participating organizations may charge additional fees to offset the cost of plate production and a contribution to the organization. Please contact the organization representative for correct payment method. DO NOT SEND CASH.
- No specialty plate will be duplicated. If your plate is lost, stolen or defaced you will need to reapply for a specialty plate by completing this application and submitting with the appropriate fees. Should you need an immediate replacement plate, please complete and submit Form MV-44, "Application for Duplicate Registration Card, Replacement of Registration Plate, Renewal Sticker or Weight Class Sticker" and submitting a fee of \$7.50. A standard issued plate will be issued until the replacement specialty plate can be provided. (Note: Form MV-44 is available on our website at www.dmv.state.pa.us.)
- Requests for specialty registration plates are restricted to passenger vehicles, trucks and motorhomes with a registered gross weight of not more than 10,000 lbs. **Motorcycles and trailers do not qualify for specialty registration plates.**
- NO REFUND OF FEE will be issued when applicant cancels request after order is placed.
- When the applicant ceases to be a member in the organization as listed in Section B, the registration plate must be returned to the Department. Complete Form MV-44 and submit a fee of \$7.50 for reissue of a regular series registration plate.
- Specialty plates are issued in number sequence only and may not be personalized.
- To avoid possible problems with citations with your old registration plate, return it to: Department of Transportation, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, Return Tag Unit, P.O. Box 68597, Harrisburg, PA 17106-8597 after you have received your special organization plate.
- Please allow 4-6 weeks for delivery.
- If applying for a Fraternal Order of Police plate, the PA State Lodge seal and the PA State Lodge Recording Secretary signature must be affixed to this application.

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Who can apply for the Boilermakers License Plate?** Any Union Boilermaker (active or retired) or family member who owns a non-commercial motor vehicle registered in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 2. Does this specialty plate program have the official approval of the International?** Yes, Local 13's Scholarship Fund has been given the endorsement of the International President to establish a specialty plate program. The International receives no proceeds from the plate.
- 3. What kinds of vehicles can I get a Boilermakers plate for?** Any passenger car, truck or motor home with a gross registered vehicle weight of 10,000 pounds or less.
- 4. Can I get a Boilermakers plate for my motorcycle?** No, specialty organization plates are not available for motorcycles.
- 5. Can I get a custom inscription (name, slogan or number) on my plate?** No, the Boilermakers specialty plates are numbered consecutively in the order the application is received by PennDOT.
- 6. Why doesn't the plate have the name and number of my local on it?** The Boilermakers specialty plate bears the inscription "Intl Brotherhood of Boilermakers" so that they could be made available to ANY Boilermaker with a vehicle registered in PA regardless of home or shop local.
- 7. What is the cost of the specialty plate?** There is a **one-time charge** of \$50.00 for the specialty plate. This charge is in addition to your annual registration renewal. You would only pay the annual renewal fee every year afterwards.
- 8. What will the proceeds from this program be used for?** All proceeds from this program will benefit the Jeffrey C. Davis Memorial Scholarship Fund.
- 9. Can I receive a tax benefit from purchasing a Boilermaker specialty plate?** Boilermakers Local 13 Scholarship Fund is a registered 501(c)(3) charitable organization, so a portion of the purchase price may be tax deductible. Consult your tax accountant for details.
- 10. What kind of information will I have to provide to obtain a Boilermaker plate?** You will need to fill out the PennDOT specialty plate application. In addition, you will need to provide your registration number and your home local in order for your application to be processed.
- 11. Where do I send the application?** All applications must be sent to Local 13 for processing with a check or money order for \$50.00 payable to **Boilermakers Local 13 Scholarship Fund**. PennDOT **will not** accept an application for a Boilermaker plate sent from any other source. PennDOT will then send the license plate and new owners card directly to you.
- 12. What do I do with my current license plate?** PennDOT will send you instructions on what to do with your current plate. When you receive your Boilermakers plate your current plate will no longer be valid.
