*****NUCLEAR ALERT*** We will need manpower for two jobs this fall at Exelon Peach Bottom.**

PCI Energy/Westinghouse @ Exelon Peach Bottom, 9/7/14. Reactor Steam Dryer replacement. PCI Energy has a contract to replace the Unit 2 reactor steam dryer and will need 24 welders and 12 mechanics. In-processing starts at Peach Bottom on 8/26/14. **Welders will be required to take a weld test and perform mockup training at the hall during the week of 8/18/14.** Test will be a 309SS test administered on a heavy wall carbon tube. Test will be performed using 100% TIG. Job schedule will be three weeks of 6-8s working two shifts, starting 9/7/14.

CBI @ Exelon Peach Bottom, 10/20/14. Unit 2 maintenance outage. Currently, CBI manpower requirements are 30 mechanics and 24 welders. Job schedule will be four weeks of 6-10s working two shifts, starting 10/20/14. Job scope to include installation of 5 stainless feedwater heater liners, condenser expansion joint replacement, misc. condenser repairs, misc. feedwater heater maintenance and condensate storage tank mods. Pre-screen dates currently unavailable, but will most likely take place throughout September.
