- ***New TWIC Enrollment Requirements*** Effective July 1, 2015 the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) has adopted new enrollment requirements for U.S. born TWIC applicants. TSA is making this change to align TWIC proof-of-citizenship requirements with those of other TSA Programs. Before applying for a TWIC card, be sure to visit www.tsa.gov to review the updated list of acceptable documentation.


