MOST sent renewal cards to everyone who hasn't tested from February 1, 2013 to the present so they know that they need to test. **Anyone who does not comply with the new policy by that date will move to the ineligible list until a negative drug screen has been completed and received by the MOST office.** Any questions please contact MOST at 800-395-1089.

*****New TWIC Enrollment Requirements***** Effective July 1, 2015 the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) has adopted new enrollment requirements for U.S. born TWIC applicants. TSA is making this change to align TWIC proof-of-citizenship requirements with those of other TSA Programs. Before applying for a TWIC card, be sure to visit www.tsa.gov to review the updated list of acceptable documentation.

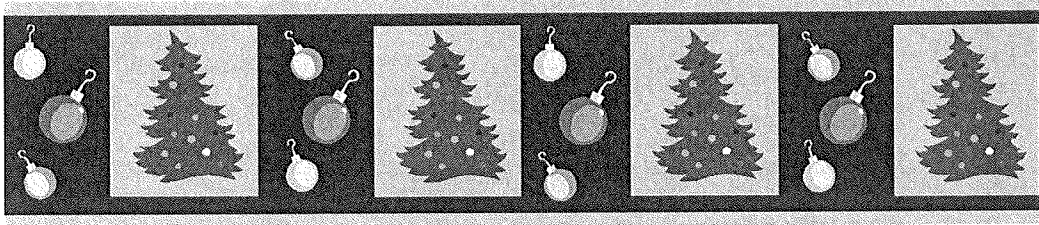
