*****Testing for the Jeffrey C. Davis and Boilermakers #13 Academic Scholarship*****

*****Scholarship Application Deadline October 9, 2015*****

Applications were recently mailed. Testing will be on Saturday, November 14, 2015 with a snow date of Saturday, November 21, 2015 at St. Joseph's University, Philadelphia Pennsylvania. Applicants are only able to apply for one of the scholarships, the academic scholarship or the Jeffrey C. Davis Scholarship, not both. Please make sure you complete and return the correct application that your son or daughter is applying for. All applications must be returned to the union hall by Friday, October 9, 2015.

*****Register to Vote***** Election Day is fast approaching and it's important for EVERY member to be registered to vote. Please contact your respective county board of election to register to vote or check your registration status. If you believe you won't be able to vote in person on Election Day, make sure to request an absentee ballot.

*****MOST Annual Drug Testing Reinstated***** The MOST Board of Trustees have amended the Drug Policy to include annual testing. This new policy will take effect on August 31, 2015. MOST sent renewal cards to everyone who hasn't tested from February 1, 2013 to the present so they know that they need to test. **Anyone who does not comply with the new policy by that date will move to the ineligible list until a negative drug screen has been completed and received by the MOST office.** Any questions please contact MOST at 800-395-1089.

*****New TWIC Enrollment Requirements***** Effective July 1, 2015 the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) has adopted new enrollment requirements for U.S. born TWIC applicants. TSA is making this change to align TWIC proof-of-citizenship requirements with those of other TSA Programs. Before applying for a TWIC card, be sure to visit www.tsa.gov to review the updated list of acceptable documentation.
