*****Testing for the Jeffrey C. Davis and Boilermakers #13 Academic Scholarship*****

Applications were recently mailed. Testing will be on November 12, 2016 with a snow date of November 19, 2016 at St. Joseph's University, Philadelphia Pennsylvania. Applicants are only able to apply for one of the scholarships, the academic scholarship or the Jeffery C. Davis Scholarship, not both. Please make sure you complete and return the correct application that your son or daughter is applying for. All applications must be returned to the union hall by October 21, 2016.

*****Boilermakers Local #13 Academic Scholarship***** this scholarship is worth \$8,000.00 and is for seniors going into an accredited College or University in fall of 2017.

*****Jeffery C. Davis Vocational Scholarship***** this scholarship is worth \$2,400.00 and is for seniors going into studies at any accredited vocational or Technical studies at any accredited vocational or technical school. Please note that this does not include studies in a 2 or 4 year degree program.

*****Field Dues Increase***** We have been advised by the International President, Newton B. Jones and Articles 20.3.6.6.: effective February 1, 2016 our field dues assessment increased from 5.25 percent (5.25%) to 6.00 percent (6.00%) of gross income.

*****MOST BDS Requirements Effective January 1, 2016***** Recently adopted changes to the national referral rules require members to meet a list of minimum criteria to be eligible for dispatch from the primary list starting January 1, 2016. If you need any classes please contact the union hall as soon as possible to register for the next available training session. Be sure to visit the local 13 website for updates to the training schedule.

*****Monthly Dues***** Monthly dues increased to \$44.40 per month effective January 1, 2016. Remember to put your registration number on your check. Due to security concerns please do not put your social security number on your check, only your registration number. **Local #13 will make every attempt to contact any member whose dues are in arrears. After 60 days you will be suspended and a \$500.00 reinstatement fee will be imposed.** It is your obligation to the union to pay union dues on time.

*****MOST Annual Drug Testing Reinstated***** The MOST Board of Trustees have amended the Drug Policy to include annual testing. This new policy took effect on August 31, 2015. Anyone who does not comply with the new policy by that date will move to the ineligible list until a negative drug screen has been completed and received by the MOST office. *****TWIC Enrollment Requirements***** Effective July 1, 2015 the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) adopted new enrollment requirements for U.S. born TWIC applicants. TSA is making this change to align TWIC proof-of-citizenship requirements with those of other TSA Programs. Before applying for a TWIC card, be sure to visit www.tsa.gov to review the updated list of acceptable documentation.
