Congress: Don't Refinery Shutdowns Destroy Our Community

The shutdown of the Philadelphia, Marcus Hook and Trainer refineries could devastate our entire region. More than 3,000 of us will lose our jobs directly and these shutdowns could eliminate more than 20,000 additional jobs.

Directions To USW 10-1 Union Hall at Marcus Hook

From Philadelphia and North

Take I-95 South to Exit 2 (Route 452). Make a left at the end of the exit on to Rt. 452 (Market St). Follow Market Street to first traffic light and make a right on to Laughead Ave. At the first stop sign, make a left on to Huddel Ave. On Huddel Ave, go straight through first traffic light at Chichester Ave. Immediately after the light, you will come to a stop sign. Make a left at the stop sign on to Palmer Drive (Palmer Drive is an alleyway). The Union Hall will be the stone building on your right at the end of Palmer Drive.

From Wilmington and South

Take I-95 North to Exit 1 (Chichester Ave). Make a right at the end of the exit on to Chichester Ave. Follow Chichester Ave to the first traffic light and make a right on to Huddel Ave. Immediately after making the right, you will come to a stop sign. Make a left at the stop sign on to Palmer Drive (Palmer Drive is an alleyway). The Union Hall will be the stone building on your right at the end of Palmer Drive.

From New Jersey

Crossing the Walt Whitman Bridge- After passing thru toll area, stay to the right and take first exit toward Front Street and I-95. Follow signs to I-95 south. Take I-95 South to Exit 2 (Route 452). Make a left at the end of the exit on to Rt. 452 (Market St). Follow Market Street to first traffic light and make a right on to Laughead Ave. At the first stop sign, make a left on to Huddel Ave. On Huddel Ave, go straight through first traffic light at Chichester Ave. Immediately after the light, you will come to a stop sign. Make a left at the stop sign on to Palmer Drive (Palmer Drive is an alleyway). The Union Hall will be the stone building on your right at the end of Palmer Drive. Crossing the Com. Barry Bridge- On the downside of the bridge, get into the left lane (toward Delaware). Go under the overpass and stay in the left lane and merge onto I-95 south. Stay in the right lane now and continue to exit 2 (Route 452). Make a left at the end of the exit on to Rt. 452 (Market St). Follow Market Street to first traffic light and make a right on to Laughead Ave. At the first stop sign, make a left on to Huddel Ave. On Huddel Ave, go straight through first traffic light at Chichester Ave. Immediately after the light, you will come to a stop sign. Make a left at the end of Palmer Drive (Palmer Drive is an alleyway). The Union Hall will be the stone building on your right at the end of Palmer Drive.

To Sunoco Philadelphia Refinery pick up

From Philadelphia and North

Take I-95 South. Merge onto Vine St Expy/I-676W/US-30W via exit 22 toward Central Phila. Take the I-76E exit toward the Int'l Airport. Merge onto I-76 E via the exit on the left toward Int'l Airport. Take the Oregon Ave exit (Exit 347) toward Passyunk Ave. Turn right onto W. Passyunk Ave. Turn left at light at 28th St followed by an immediate right onto Frontage Rd.

From Wilmington and South

Take I-95 North toward Philadelphia. Take the PA 291 E exit (exit 10) toward Bartram Ave/Cargo City. Merge onto Industrial Highway. Turn left onto Bartram Ave/ PA291E. Continue to follow Bartram Ave. Turn left onto Essington Ave. Stay straight to go onto Passyunk Ave. Make a right at 28th St (exit is before 28th St) followed by an immediate right onto Frontage Rd.
